Volunteer Ian Ryan (Captain Eamonn Ryan's son) is in contention for a position with Snohomish 7. Both were very active with the department and will be missed.

Chief Nohr summarized recent major calls and the training burn on January 16. Chief Nohr and BC Konkright were able to review the video of a cardiac event at ilani. With the permission of security staff we may take advantage of the opportunity to review other incidents post-event to critique performance and enhance our service delivery. Update on the school district property acquisition status – has been delayed to March 1. Legal counsel are reviewing some contract issues and we are still investigating the buildability of the location. Architect Karl Johansson has been extremely helpful in finding resources for the assessment. Update on the Local 3674 Fire Fighter Unit CBA. A TA'd agreement has been sent to the body for review. Should have something for the Board at the next meeting.
